PRESENTING SYMPTOMS AND HISTORY

Noticed that when he is running in the evening he can't see so well and has been bumping into things more often. Feeling a little more concerned about driving at night.

Otherwise distance and near vision seems pretty much ok.

Noticed some problems seeing all 6 screens at work.

Wears present spectacles most of the time, needs them for work as screens are just beyond arm's length away.

No headaches, no flashes or floaters, no diplopia.


