Age: 48 years

Occupation: Joiner, Drives. Hobbies: golf. Smoker

Last eye examination: 2.5 years RE +1.25/-0.25 x 180 6/5

LE +1.50/-0.50 x 170 6/5 Add +1.50 N6 R&L

Would like to try contact lenses. Is now having to wear glasses more often and has struggled to get on with varifocals. Also struggling to read recording card and see ball when playing golf. Wearing varifocals when necessary. Feels NV could be better in them.

No previous contact lens wear. Would like lenses for golf and social wear. Wears prescription safety spectacles at work.

Symptoms: nil

OH: glaucoma. Last HES check 1/12, due again in 11/12

FOH: nil

GH: High BP, controlled by meds. Last medical exam 3/12, all OK.

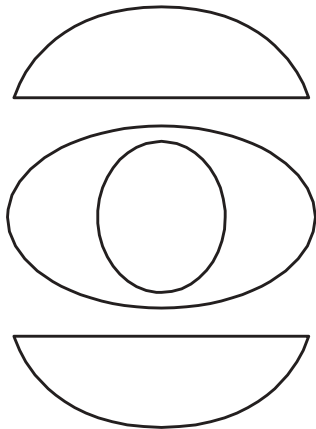
FGH: Father heart attack

External examination

Mild blepharitis, grade 0.5 MGD



Grade 1 limbal hyperaemia nasally R&L

No corneal staining R or L

tBUT 18 seconds R&L
