PRESENTING SYMPTOMS AND HISTORY Had new specs 3 months ago and feels they are “not quite right”. VA not as good as expected and caught the wing mirror in car yesterday – feels it was due to new specs. On questioning, agrees that specs felt fine at collection and was wearing them happily until the past couple of weeks.

CONVERGENCE 10cm LE breaks


